Introduction to HNUST 湖南科技大学简介

Hunan University of Science and Technology (HNUST) which evolved from Northern Hunan Construction College founded in 1949, was established in 2003 by the merger of two separate universities: Xiangtan Institute of Technology and Xiangtan Normal University.

The campus covers an area of over 3,003.88 mu (approximately 201 hectares). As a complex of 21 schools, together with International Education College, Adult Higher Education College, and Sanya Research Institute, HNUST offers 91 academic programs across 11 disciplines. Six disciplines, namely engineering, chemistry, computer science, material science, earth science and environment (ecology), are ranked among the top 1% globally in ESI. It has 7 postdoctoral research stations, 10 doctoral programs, and 50 master programs. According to the 2024 Soft Science University Rankings, HNUST ranks 184th; and according to the US News World University Rankings, it ranked 988th in 2022.

HNUST has a staff of about 2,700 including 1,850 full-time faculty. There are 40,588 full-time undergraduate students, 7,206 graduate students, and an additional 186 international students currently enrolled.

HNUST has established good cooperative relationships with more than 100 universities in over 30 countries and regions, including the United States, the United Kingdom, Russia, Canada, Switzerland, Australia, Germany, Italy, Sweden, Spain, Austria, Ireland, Japan, and South Korea, etc. It has recruited international students from 35 countries and students from Hong Kong, Macao, and Taiwan of China.



Introduction to International Education

The College of International Education at HNUST was established in 2017 and operates in collaboration with the International Exchange Office and Hong Kong, Macao, and Taiwan Affairs Office of the university. From the beginning, the school has adhered to the concept of a global community with a shared future, striving to create a new chapter in international education for the modern era. It promotes the university's internationalization from a global perspective and aims to build a high-level, comprehensive institution with distinct characteristics—leading in China and influential worldwide.

The university has actively established strong cooperative relationships with nearly 100 universities across 30 countries and regions, including the United States, the United Kingdom, Russia, Australia, Germany, Italy, Sweden, Austria, Ireland, Japan, South Korea, Thailand, Malaysia, and Vietnam, as well as Taiwan and Macao. In 2015, it was first approved for the "National High-End Foreign Experts" program and the "Hunan Province 100 Foreign Experts Program."

Since gaining approval to enroll international students in 2011, the university's 18 colleges have offered 58 majors to outstanding students from around the world. The international student population has expanded rapidly, now representing 35 countries. The university provides education at multiple levels, including undergraduate, master's, and doctoral programs, forming a system primarily focused on degree education, supplemented by long- and short-term Chinese language training. The annual enrollment exceeds 100 students, and the number of international students cultivated is nearly 1000.






Why Choose HNUST



A Wide Range of Specialties



The university consists of 21 teaching colleges, along with the School of International Education, Sanya Research Institute, School of Excellent Engineers, School of Innovation and Entrepreneurship, Zhaotan Academy, and School of Education. It offers 91 undergraduate majors across 11 disciplinary categories, including science, engineering, literature, education, philosophy, law, economics, management, art, history, agriculture, and interdisciplinary studies.

Six disciplines—engineering, chemistry, computer science, materials science, earth science, and environment/ecology—rank in the top 1% of the ESI global rankings. The university has 7 first-level discipline postdoctoral research mobile stations, 9 first-level discipline doctorate authorization points, 30 first-level discipline master's degree authorization points, and 20 professional master's degree authorization categories. It also holds the recommendation qualification for outstanding undergraduate graduates to pursue a master's degree without taking the entrance examination, as well as the "Master-Teacher Plan" exemption qualification.

The university has been recognized for its academic excellence, including:


- **One "World-Class Cultivation Discipline"** in Hunan Province

Well-qualified Faculty and Staff

HNUST currently employs nearly 2700 faculty and staff, including **1,850** full-time teachers, among whom **940** hold senior professional titles. 71% of full-time teachers have earned a doctoral degree.

The faculty includes 2 specially appointed academicians and **25** individuals selected for national high-level talent programs or equivalent recognitions. Additionally, 106 faculty members have been selected for provincial high-level talent programs or equivalent honors.

More than 10 faculty members have received prestigious national awards, such as National Outstanding Engineer (first batch), Role Models of the Times, National Distinguished Teacher, National "Most Beautiful Teacher" , National Model Teacher, and National Excellent Teacher. The university also has two Huang Danian-style teacher teams recognized at the national level.



Highlight & Excellence



HNUST currently has more than **40,000** full-time undergraduate students, over **7000** postgraduate students, and **about 200** international students.

In recent years, many outstanding students have emerged, including members of the Mathematical Modeling Competition Science and Technology Innovation Team, recognized as a "Xiaoping Science and Technology Innovation Team" among national college students. Notable individuals include:

Many students go on to pursue further studies at prestigious institutions or dedicate themselves to serving the country where they are needed most, embodying the spirit of youth and ambition.

Strong Platform Support & Rich Academic Atmosphere



HNUST is home to 47 national and provincial/ministerial-level platforms for natural science and technological innovation, along with 20 provincial research bases dedicated to social sciences.

Since the commencement of the 12th Five-Year Plan period, the university has undertaken 1,061 national-level projects, including those under the 863 Program, 973 Program, National Key R&D Program, National Natural Science Foundation of China, and National Social Science Foundation of China.

HNUST's research achievements have been recognized with 225 national and provincial/ministerial-level scientific research awards. Intellectual property accomplishments include 4,399 nationally authorized patents and software copyrights, with 271 scientific research outcomes successfully commercialized for practical applications.

Well-equipped Facilities & Abundant Resources



HNUST spans 3,003.88 mu (approximately 200 hectares) with a building area of 1,184,300 square meters. The total value of its teaching and scientific research equipment amounts to 933.2 million yuan. The library houses a collection of over 3 million printed books, subscribes to 79 various literature databases, and has accumulated approximately 930,000 e-books, 1.2 million e-journals, and more than 11.22 million electronic dissertations and theses.

The College of International Education provides standard double-room dormitories for all international students. Each dormitory is equipped with air conditioning, wireless internet, private bathrooms, balconies, and access to public kitchens, ensuring a comfortable living environment.

Additionally, the university offers modern sports facilities, including a real-ice rink, a taekwondo hall, a basketball hall, and a fencing hall, making it an ideal environment for both study and recreation.

Financial Support & Colorful Culture



HNUST offers comprehensive scholarships for outstanding international students. In addition, the university enjoys an excellent geographical location and convenient transportation. It boasts a rich cultural heritage, a wide range of cultural and sports activities, and a pleasant academic and living environment.

Located in the core urban area of Xiangtan City, the university is approximately a 20-minute drive from both the high-speed railway and inter-city railway stations and about an hour's drive from Huanghua Airport. With the opening of the Changsha- Zhuzhou-Xiangtan Metro West Ring Line this year, travel to Xiangtan now takes just 30 minutes, while reaching Changsha from the university takes less than 20 minutes.

At HNUST, international students are invited to immerse themselves in authentic Chinese culture and vibrant local Hunan traditions. Our rich cultural programs feature Chinese calligraphy, paper cutting, martial arts, and other classic cultural experiences. You will also explore distinctive Hunan culture, savor authentic local cuisine, and engage in close interactions with Chinese peers. Here, you will gain profound insights into China's history, customs and contemporary life, and enjoy a rewarding, cross-cultural and unforgettable study.



Scenic Campus

Types of International Student Admission Programs

- **“1+X” Language + Academic Joint Training Program:** The "1+X" structure means 1 year of Chinese language study plus X years of standard study duration for the corresponding degree program (e.g., 1+4 for undergraduate programs, 1+3 for master's programs, and 1+4 for doctoral programs). Specifically, international students first complete one-year Chinese language study at our university. After reaching the admission standards in terms of language proficiency and comprehensive abilities and being approved by HNUST, they can proceed to pursue the degree program for the specified duration. Prior to enrollment, students must sign the Informed Consent Form for the "1+X" Language + Degree Joint Training Program. Outstanding students may apply for scholarships, including Hunan Province's "Belt and Road" Language Student Scholarship or Hunan University of Science and Technology's "Belt and Road" Language Student Scholarship. These two scholarships are not awarded concurrently.

- **The International Degree-seeking Student Recruitment Program comprises three categories:** undergraduate, master's, and doctoral programs. Applicants must meet the admission standards set by the national authorities and our university for their chosen level. Upon passing the admission assessment at HNUST, students will be enrolled in our degree programs. Outstanding students may apply for scholarships: note that only one type of scholarship will be awarded per student.



Study Duration

- **Language Student: 1 year** (Students must complete one year of language training and achieve a minimum HSK4 score of 180 to qualify for the degree program).
- **Undergraduate: 4 years** (5 years for Architecture and Urban-Rural Planning majors).
- **Master's: 3 years.**
- **Doctoral: 4 years.**

- "Hunan University of Science and Technology International Student Family Information Form"
- "Hunan University of Science and Technology International Student Application Form"
- Valid passport scan (valid for more than 1 year), if there has been a China visa, provide the latest China visa page
- "Foreigner Physical Examination Form" scan (dated after March 1, 2026)
- Scan of the highest academic degree certificate (proof of expected graduation) and transcript scan, non-Chinese/English text must be accompanied by notarized Chinese/English translation (doctoral program applicants must provide undergraduate and master's degree certificates)
- HSK, HSKK score report (valid for within 2 years)
- CSCA score report (undergraduate program applicants)
- Two letters of recommendation in Chinese/English signed by professors or associate professors (master's and doctoral program applicants)
- Chinese/English study and research plan for coming to China (master's no less than 800 words, doctoral no less than 3000 words)
- Certificate of no criminal record (issued after March 1, 2026)
non-Chinese/English text must be accompanied by notarized Chinese/English translation
- Students applying for art-related majors must submit their own works
- Scan of published academic papers or other research results
- Applicants under 18 years old Submit a power of attorney signed by the guardian in China
- Provide a bank deposit certificate for the specified amount (no less than one year's tuition fee)



Application and Admission Procedures

- Download relevant forms from the website <http://dwll.hnust.edu.cn/zlxz/lhlx/index.htm>. "Foreigner Physical Examination Form", "Hunan University of Science and Technology International Student Family Information Form", and "Hunan University of Science and Technology International Student Academic Application Form";
- Applicants must strictly follow the items specified in the "Foreigner Physical Examination Form" and undergo examinations at local public hospitals. The "Foreigner Physical Examination Form" will be invalid if it lacks required items, does not include a personal photo, lacks a seam seal, lacks physician and hospital signatures/seals, or lacks an examination date. The examination date must be after March 1, 2026;
- HNUST will organize internal experts to conduct preliminary reviews of the application materials;

- Applicants who pass the preliminary review will be scheduled for interviews, and those who fail the interview will not be admitted;
- The university will select candidates based on application materials and review results, with the final funding category determined by the received admission notice;
- Confirm the completion of Chinese study procedures.

Note: The above application materials will not be returned, regardless of whether the applicant is admitted.




Accommodation Information

Double-bed room at Residence Hall (shared by two): CNY500/Month/Person.

The Residence Hall is a separate 6-storied building, which can hold 280 international students. The building is equipped with entrance guard system and monitoring system. There is a public kitchen, dining hall and laundry place on each floor, equipped with public refrigerator, washing machine, Electromagnetic furnace and dining tables and chairs.

Each room is provided with a bedroom, an independent living balcony, an independent washroom, two individual beds, two wardrobes, two bed stands, air-conditioner, and hot water.





Requirements

★ **Identity:** Non-Chinese citizens with sound physical and mental health, excellent character and academic performance.

★ **Ethical Requirements:** Have no criminal record, and comply with the laws and regulations of the People's Republic of China as well as the university's rules and regulations..

★ **Age Requirements:** Applicants must be between 16 and 35 years old. Specifically, undergraduate program applicants shall not exceed 25 years old, and master's program applicants shall not exceed 30 years old.

★ **Educational Qualification Requirements:** Applicants must be high school graduates or above, with a valid passport. Specifically, applicants for a bachelor's degree must hold a high school diploma or higher. Applicants for a master's degree must hold a bachelor's degree. Applicants for a doctoral degree must hold a master's degree.

★ **Language Proficiency Requirements:** Applicants for degree programs must attain a minimum HSK score of 180. Those who do not meet the Chinese proficiency requirement shall complete a one-year language training program prior to formal enrollment.

Note:

- Undergraduate programs: Priority admission is granted to applicants who have passed the CSCA exam.
- Business School (Master's): Priority consideration for applicants with advanced mathematics coursework and a solid foundation in economics or management.
- Business School (PhD): Preferential admission for candidates with completed coursework in calculus, linear algebra, probability theory and mathematical statistics, plus a strong background in economics or management.
